



An independent, faith-based charitable organization offering emergency shelter, food, clothing and rehabilitation to London's homeless and disadvantaged through five branches of service:

The Men's Mission and Rehabilitation Centre – 146-bed emergency & transitional shelter for men, 16 and over. · **Quintin Warner House** – 16-bed residential, addictions treatment program for men. **Rotholme Women's and Family Shelter** – 41-bed emergency shelter for single women 16 and over and families. Priority given to families. · **Community Mental Health Programs** – counselling and life skills for those in shelter with a mental illness; specialized shelter beds (Crashbeds) for those unable to cope in a traditional shelter; outreach service for the homeless, mentally ill living on the street (Streetscape). · **The Mission Store** – quality clothing and household articles at modest prices or free through voucher system.
